

Viewing the Site

This website is optimized to be viewed on either Internet Explorer 5.0 or above, or Netscape Navigator 6.0 or above and Safari 1.0 or above at a minimum screen resolution of 1024 x 768, although an ideal screen resolution would be 1152 x 864 for example.

Site Navigation

The navigation has been designed to be as user-friendly as possible, allowing all site content to be viewed within the minimum number of mouse clicks.

The general area of interest is selected via the 'tabs' at the top of each page. Each page then features a menu along the top where visitors find more detail on particular topics.

Use the Resources section to find all downloadable materials such as PDF's and for links to the Open Usergroup etc.

Using the Browser Back Button

To return to the previously visited page, users can simply click on the back button of the browser. Alternatively, the user can select the item directly from any of the navigational tools. A link is also included in most pages offering the facility to back up from the current page.

PDF Files (Portable Document Format)

The website includes a number of PDF files that can be viewed online or downloaded to view at a later stage. You will need to install Adobe Acrobat Reader in order to view these files. To download the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader, free of charge, go to www.adobe.com.
